# Lesson 1: Academic Excellence

Giving God your best through preparation, diligence, honesty and improvement.

Joshua 1:8 Connection

**Excellence is not merely being the smartest student. It is becoming faithful with your mind, your work and your opportunities.**

## Excellence means:

- Come prepared
- Listen carefully
- Ask questions
- Complete assignments
- Study before the last minute
- Receive correction
- Do honest work
- Improve after mistakes
- Use gifts for God's glory



## TEACH GIRLS

Excellence is a worship response. Carelessness should not wear the crown when God gave you gifts.

# Lesson 2: Study Habits

Good students do not depend only on motivation. They build routines.

## 1. Prepare

Gather books, notes, pens and assignments.

## 2. Remove Distractions

Put away unnecessary phones, games, TV and social media.

## 3. Focus

Work on one assignment at a time.

## 4. Review

Explain the lesson, answer questions and review mistakes.

## 5. Rest

Sleep, movement, water and healthy breaks help the brain learn.



### TEACH GIRLS

Twenty focused minutes beats two distracted hours. Focus is a muscle. Train it.

**I train my mind to focus. I study with purpose.**

# Lesson 3: Discipline

Discipline means doing what is right and necessary, even when you do not feel like it.

## Jericho Connection

Israel marched according to God's instruction. They could not march only when they felt excited. They had to follow the plan completely.

### Discipline looks like:

- Rise on time
- Complete chores without repeated reminders
- Read the Bible consistently
- Study before entertainment
- Keep promises
- Control emotions and words
- Finish assignments
- Return to the plan after a mistake

### TEACH GIRLS

### TEACH GIRLS

Money is a tool. It should be managed with wisdom, not used to prove worth, follow pressure or impress people.

With God's wisdom, I will give, save, plan and spend responsibly.

# Lesson 6: Saving, Budgeting & Stewardship

Inheritance has value, boundaries, purpose and responsibility.

Joshua 13-19 Connection

The land was divided carefully among the tribes. Stewardship means managing what belongs to God with honesty, gratitude and care.

### TEACH GIRLS

Do not save only what remains after spending. Decide what you will save before the money disappears.

## A Simple Girl's Budget



If you receive \$20, decide first what will be given, saved, used for a goal and spent.

## Stewardship includes managing:

- Time
- Talents
- School supplies
- Clothing
- Opportunities
- Technology
- Relationships
- Responsibilities

I am a faithful steward. I care for what God places in my hands.



# Lesson 7: Wise Decision-Making

Not every attractive choice is wise. Not every invitation deserves a yes.

Joshua 9 Connection

Israel made an agreement with the Gibeonites without asking counsel from the Lord. A wise girl pauses before she agrees, responds, follows, posts, spends or commits.

## The AHAVAH Wise Decision Check

**A - Ask God**

Have I prayed?

**A - Ask Counsel**

What do parents or mentors advise?

**A - Align With Purpose**

Does this support who God calls me to be?

**H - Hear the Word**

What does Scripture teach?

**V - View Consequences**

Where could this lead?

**H - Have Courage**

Will I obey even when unpopular?



TEACH GIRLS

A wise girl does not rush because she feels pressured. She pauses long enough to hear God and examine consequences.

I will ask God and choose wisdom.
